Conclusion

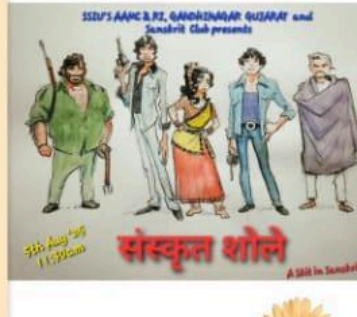
